Installation

The installation in this manual is intended for qualified installers, service technicians or persons with similar qualified background. DO NOT attempt to install this appliance yourself. Injury could result from installing the unit due to lack of appropriate electrical and technical background.

All electrical wiring must be properly installed, insulated and grounded. Overly accumulated grease in old duct work should be cleaned out or duct work should be replaced if necessary to avoid the possibility of a grease fire. Check all joints on duct work to insure proper connection and all joints should be properly taped.

Operations

Read all instructions in this manual before operating the appliance. Save these instructions for future reference.

Always leave safety grills and filters in place. Without these components, operating blowers could catch on to hair, fingers and loose clothing.

NEVER dispose cigarette ashes, ignitable substances, or any foreign objects into blowers.

NEVER leave cooking unattended. When frying, oil in the pan can easily overheat and catch fire. The risk of self combustion is higher when the oil has been used several times.

Cleaning

The saturation of greasy residue in the blower and filters may cause increased flammability. Keep unit clean and free of grease and residue build-up at all times to prevent possible fires.

Filters must be cleaned periodically and kept free from accumulation of cooking residue (see cleaning instructions inside). Old and worn filters must be replaced immediately. Do not operate blowers when filters are removed. Never disassemble parts to clean without proper instructions. Disassembly is recommended to be performed by qualified personnel only. 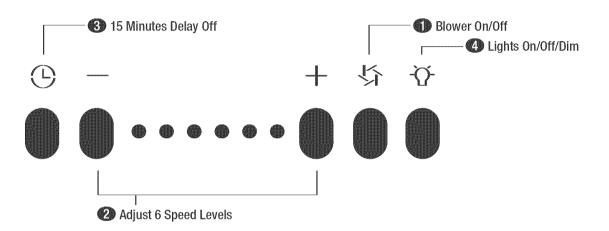

- Blower On/Off

 By pressing 坊, the blower is switched On and Off.
- Speed Selection
 The 6 speed levels are selected by pressing to decrease and + to increase speed level.
 The display indicates level selected.
- 3 Delay Off
 This is used for programmed shut down of blower and lights 15 minutes after the function is activated. After pressing (1), the hood will completely shut down in 15 minutes.
- 4 Lights On/Off/Dim
 Switch lights On and Off by pressing -\(\overline{\cappa}\)- once. To dim lights, press and hold -\(\overline{\cappa}\)- for 2 seconds.

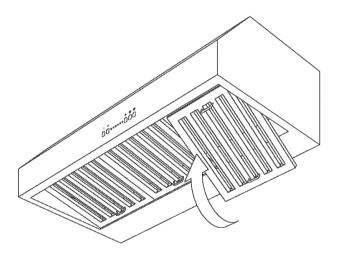
Surface Maintenance:

Clean periodically with hot soapy water and clean cotton cloth. Do not use corrosive or abrasive detergent (e.g. Comet powder scrub, Easy Off oven cleaner), or steel wool/scouring pads which will scratch and damage surface.

For heavier soil use liquid degreaser such as 'Formula 409' or 'Fantastic' brand cleaner. After cleaning, you may use non abrasive stainless steel polish/ cleaners such as 3M or ZEP, to polish and buff out the stainless luster and grain. Always scrub lightly, with clean cotton cloth, and with the grain.

Stainless Steel Baffled Filters

The stainless steel baffled filters fitted by the factory are intended to trap residue and grease from cooking. Although the filters never need replacement, they are required to be kept clean. Filters should be cleaned after every 30 hours of use.



Removing Baffled Filters

- 1. Pull filter toward back of range hood using handles.
- 2. Pivot filter front upward.
- 3. Remove downwards to the rear.

Replacing Light Bulbs



CAUTION: Light bulb becomes extremely hot when turned on.

DO NOT touch bulb until switched off and cooled. Touching hot bulbs could cause serious burns.

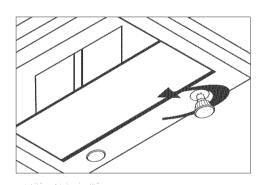
Make sure all power is turned off and bulbs are not hot.

Remove by turning bulb counterclockwise.

If bulbs are difficult to remove due to prolonged use, firmly attach a glass suction cup (readily available at most lighting stores) approximately the diameter of the bulb and turn counter clockwise. You may also use a rubber or latex glove to get the same effect.

Replacement bulbs are available at specialty lighting stores. Purchase type GU10 120V 50W halogen bulbs.

Warranty:
